

Phillipston Animal Control Fee Schedule

The licensing period for Annual dog and kennel licenses, as required by G.L. c.140, §§137 and 137A, shall be January 1st through December 30th.

When licensing a dog for the first time, proof of spay or neutering should be presented in order to be eligible for neutered or spayed license fee.

There will be a late fee per dog for licensing after March 31st in the year of issue.

The annual fee for individual dog and kennel licenses shall be as follows:

Individual Dog, Fixed	\$10
Individual Dog, Intact	\$15
Kennel, 2-8 dogs	\$60
Kennel, 9 or more dogs	\$100
Late Fee	\$25

See bylaws (article X) for daily impound fees and reclaiming fees.

Fines for loose/impounded animals:

First Offense	\$50
Second Offense	\$100
Third Offense	\$150
Fourth Offense	\$200

Subsequent offenses shall be determined as offenses occurring within two years of the date of the first noticed offense. Each day or apportion thereof shall constitute a separate offense. If there is more than one violation in a day, each violation shall constitute a separate offense.
